

# MathXL<sup>®</sup> for School

Dear Student:

Your teacher has set up a MathXL for School course for you named Honors Math 2: Yu 3<sup>rd</sup> Period Spring 2016 using *Prentice Hall Algebra II*. In order to join this class, you will first need to register for MathXL for School, then enroll in your teacher's course. We recommend that a teacher or parent guide you through this process using the instructions below.

## 1. Registering for MathXL for School

- Go to [www.mathxlforschool.com](http://www.mathxlforschool.com) and click the "Register" button on the right hand side. Read and accept the terms of agreement listed on the site.
- Where it says "Do you have a Pearson Education Account" click "No".
- Create a login and password.
- Use the access code below to log in

- Press the next button below.
- Follow the instructions on the next screen to register (Our school zip code is 27614 and you will have to manually enter the name as it is not on the list provided).
- Press NEXT
- On the following screen press LOG IN NOW
- A new screen will pop up. Press "Enter MATHXL For School"

## 2. Enrolling in your teacher's course

- After registering, log in to MathXL for School with your username and password.
- Highlight the "I am taking a course that is using MathXL for School, and need to enroll in my instructor's course." Option
- Enter our course code below

The Course ID for your 3<sup>rd</sup> Period Math 2 Honors course is: **XL05-41Z6-801Y-1RR3**

Press Enroll

You should now be enrolled in my course. The first HW assignment is listed.
